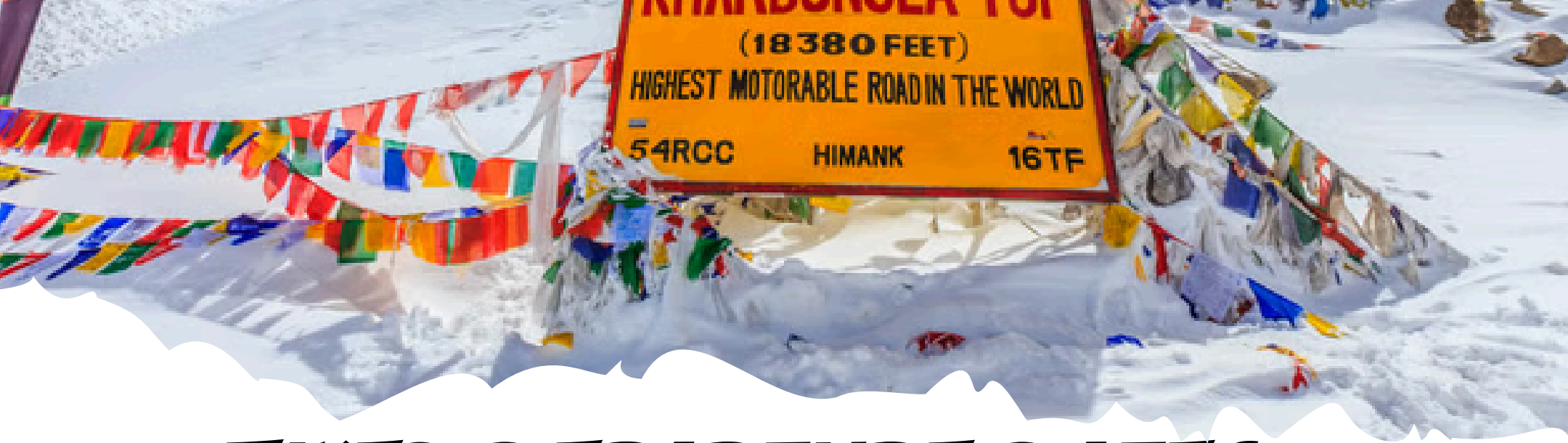

DETAILED ITINERARY -

Day 01: Arrival in Leh | Rest & Acclimatization Day (11,600 ft) . On arriving in Leh, spend rest of the day at leisure.

- We suggest you to go for a short walk around your hotel, to acclimate yourself to the altitude better.
- Later get briefed on the program and upcoming events of your journey and Enjoy dinner and overnight stay in Leh.

Day 02: Journey from Leh to Nubra Valley (10,000 ft | 160 KM | 5-6 hr)

- Wake up to a refreshing morning and enjoy breakfast.
- Travel to Nubra Valley, a cold desert with stunning landscapes and mountain ranges.
- Cross the thrilling Khardung La Pass, the world's second-highest motorable pass.
- Visit the picturesque Diskit Monastery, perched high on a hill, and soak in the breathtaking views of the valley.
- In Sand Dunes, opt for a camel ride in the desert mountains of Hunder (at additional cost).
- Hand over your bike keys to the road captain.
- Dinner and overnight stay in Nubra Valley





Day 03: Journey from Nubra Valley to Turtuk Village to Nubra Valley (9,850 ft | 196 KM | 8-9 hr)

- Start your day with a hearty breakfast.
- Pack your bags and depart for Turtuk Village, which was part of Pakistan before 1971.
- Turtuk, nestled in the Nubra tehsil 205 km from Leh, sits along the banks of the Shyok River and is the last village before the LOC.
- Marvel at the breathtaking beauty of the valley, with views unlike anything you've seen before.
- After exploring Turtuk, return to Nubra Valley.
- Hand over your bike keys to the road captain and relax with an overnight stay.
- Dinner, and overnight stay in Nubra Valley.





Day 04: Journey from Nubra Valley to Pangong Tso (14,000 ft | 160 KM | 7-8 hr)

- Start your day with a delicious breakfast.
- Gear up for another thrilling off-road adventure through the rugged mountain paths.
- Travel towards the stunning Pangong Tso (lake) via the Shyok River or the challenging Wari La Pass, a route often used by the army.
- Upon arrival, take in the mesmerising views of the blue waters of Pangong Tso.
- (*If Pangong Tso is closed, we will return to Leh and visit the lake the next day by SUV or tempo traveller).
- Enjoy the picturesque surroundings of the lake.
- Hand over your bike keys to the road captain and settle in for the night.
- Enjoy dinner and overnight stay at Pangong Tso.





Day 05: Journey from Pangong Tso to Leh via Chang La (11,600 ft | 160 KM | 5-6 hr)

- Start your morning with a hearty breakfast.
- Get ready for an exhilarating ride back to Leh, passing through the scenic Chang La Pass, the third-highest mountain pass in the world.
- On the way, stop at the iconic Rancho School, made famous by the Bollywood movie '3 Idiots.'
- If time allows, visit the beautiful Thiksey Monasteries.
- Hand over your bike keys to the road captain and unwind for the night.
- Dinner and overnight stay in Leh.

Day 06: Departure from Leh

- After breakfast, make your way to the airport for your flight home, marking the end of your journey.
- Trip concludes.

INCLUSIONS:

- Stay in pre-booked deluxe hotels on triple sharing in Leh.
- Enjoy a comfy stay in Swiss Camps with attached washrooms on triple sharing in Nubra Valley and Pangong Tso.
- The package includes elbow and knee guards, as well as a helmet.
- Buffet breakfast will be provided from Day 2 to Day 6, and buffet dinner will be available from Day 1 to Day 5.
- Himalayan Royal Enfield 411CC bikes will be available from Day 2 morning to Day 5 evening.
- Bike permits and Inner Line Permits will be arranged for all travelers.
- All necessary permits for the highest motorable passes in the world, including Khardung La and Chang La, will be included.
- Fuel will be provided according to the route specified in the itinerary.
- Services of an experienced Road Captain and motorbike mechanic will be available from Day 2 to Day 5.
- A First Aid medical kit and oxygen cylinder will be available with the Road Captain.
- Luggage can be carried in a separate vehicle, limited to one rucksack/duffle bag of 60 liters per traveler.
- An online certificate will be issued upon successful completion of the trip.



EXCLUSIONS:

- Personal expenses such as telephone calls, laundry, tips, and table drinks.
- Any type of insurance, including medical, accidental, and theft coverage.
- Airfare or rail fare not mentioned in the “Inclusions” section.
- Pick-up or drop-off services at the airport, railway station, or bus stop.
- Costs for any spare parts needed due to accidental damage while the motorbike is in the rider’s possession.
- Charges incurred for transferring or towing the motorbike, as well as vehicle servicing or maintenance costs if the bike is dropped on the way.
- Lunch and any other meals not included in the package.
- A security deposit of ₹5,000 per motorbike for accidental damages or for returning the bike if left en route before the trip's end date.
- Parking fees, as well as entry fees for monasteries and monuments during sightseeing.
- Any costs incurred due to itinerary changes, extensions, or delays caused by natural calamities, roadblocks, vehicle breakdowns, union issues, or factors beyond our control.
- Additional accommodation or food costs resulting from delays.
- Applicable GST.
- Any other expenses not mentioned in the Inclusion section.

NOTES

- The check-in time is 10 AM morning/early check-in subject to availability of the room.
- We have the right to cancel the group if we do not get the minimum strength of bikes in any group.
- If there are any additional expenses due to bad weather or any other reason beyond the control of the tour operator on account of a hotel stay, transportation, and meals, etc. extra bill will be raised. Neither we nor the participating partners/hotels will be responsible for the additional expenses.
- We are not responsible for any change in itinerary due to reasons beyond our control like change in flight and train schedule, cancellation of flights/trains, political disturbances, natural phenomenon, etc...
- If any group member wants to leave the group in-between the tour then he/she will not be eligible for any refund and has to pay the cost for transportation of bike from point of leaving the tour till the tour endpoint.
- Wearing a helmet, carrying a valid ID proof & Driving license is mandatory.
- All guests will be responsible for the safety and security of their own luggage. We will not be at all responsible for the damage / missing / lost luggage. So carry a small daypack bag to carry all the expensive things with you.
- Compensation for any damage/accident done by you during the tour to others property/person would be directly payable by you.

NOTES

- Due to any unforeseen weather conditions, road blockage, snowfall, rain, storm, the tour may continue to operate in tempo traveler instead of bikes.
- Foreign Nationals have to pay separately on their own for the permits.
- Basic First Aid Kit - It's advised that one should bring his/her own medicines which are known and suitable to him.
- Road Captain will be responsible to manage the group by taking all safety measures. The group has to follow him to make the tour a success.
- We provide a well-experienced and skilled Royal Enfield Mechanic with spare parts and tools. They are well trained to handle large groups. The spares used on the way will be chargeable.
- Backing vehicle – Bolero/Camper/Xylo/Innova/tempo for mechanical and medical support.
- Only one rucksack/backpack of 60 liters will be adjusted as it will be having tools and spares too.

For Ground Package

- To secure your booking, an initial payment of Rs. 3,000/- is required. Please note that this advance amount is non-refundable under all circumstances.
- A structured payment schedule must be followed to ensure smooth processing of your travel arrangements:

30 Days Before the Travel Date:

You are required to pay 50% of the total package cost. This allows us to initiate reservations and confirm essential travel services.

15 Days Before the Travel Date:

An additional 25% of the total package cost must be paid. This step helps us finalize and secure all necessary travel components.

7 Days Before the Travel Date:

The remaining balance, completing 100% of the total amount, must be cleared. Full payment is mandatory to process your final confirmations and travel documents.

Important:

The booking stands liable to be canceled if 100% payment is not received less than 07 days before the Date of Travel. The received amount will be forfeited.
