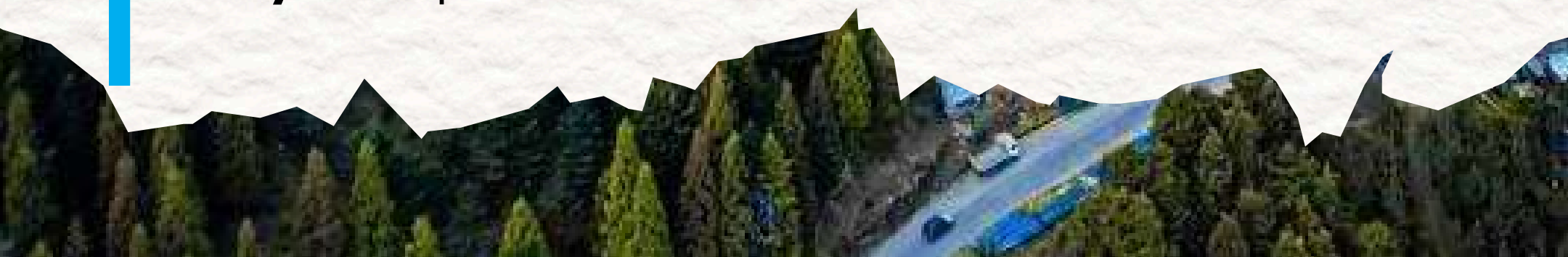

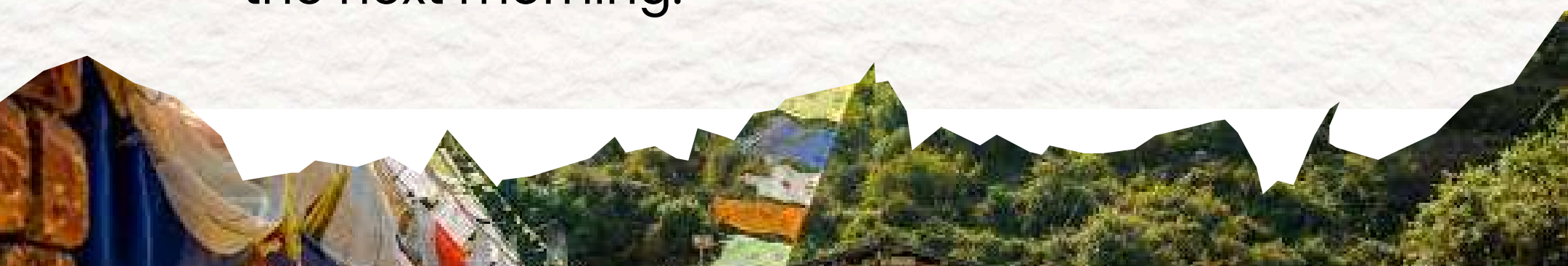




DETAILED ITINERARY

Day 1: Arrival in Guwahati | Welcome to the Gateway of Northeast India

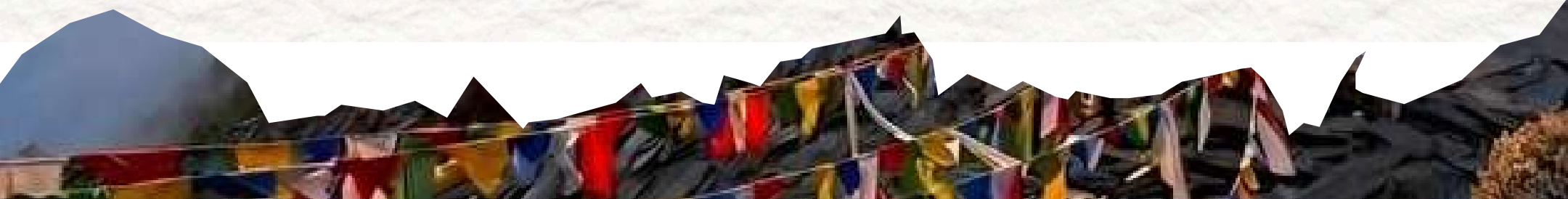
- Arrive in Guwahati, check in to your hotel, and relax before the expedition begins.

- Attend the mandatory trip briefing, covering the itinerary, riding protocols, safety guidelines, permits, weather, and road conditions.
- Meet your fellow riders during the welcome session and get to know your Ride Captain and the IYC team.
- Enjoy a welcome dinner and overnight stay in Guwahati, preparing for the ride to Shergaon the next morning.

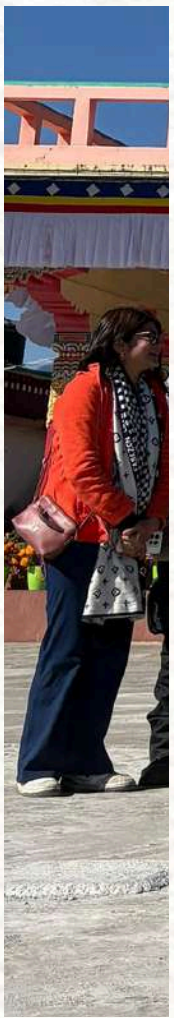




Day 2: Guwahati to Shergaon | Into the Eastern Himalayas

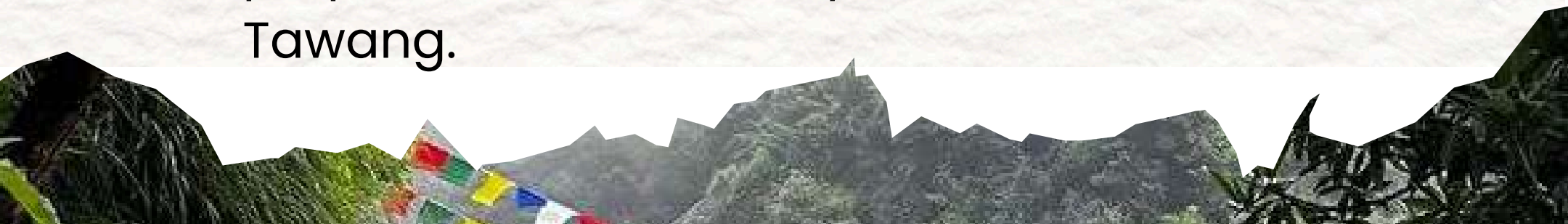
- Begin your journey from Guwahati and ride through the scenic tea gardens, forests, and villages of Assam towards Arunachal Pradesh.
- Visit Bhairabkunda and enjoy a short Bhutan border visit (subject to local regulations).
- Enter Arunachal Pradesh via Balemue Check Gate, where Inner Line Permit (ILP) verification is completed.
- Stop at Tenzin Gaon View Point to admire panoramic Himalayan views and capture memorable photographs.
- Continue through winding mountain roads before arriving at the peaceful village of Shergaon, known for its Monpa culture and apple orchards.
- Check in to your stay, enjoy dinner, and relax before the ride to Dirang the next day.

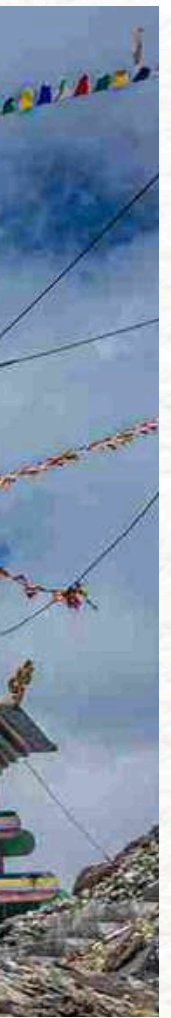
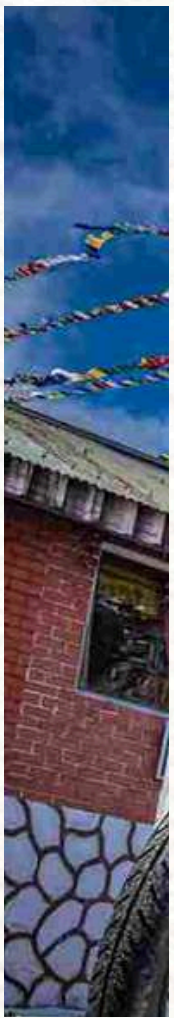




Day 3: Shergaon to Dirang | Monasteries, Valleys & Himalayan Serenity

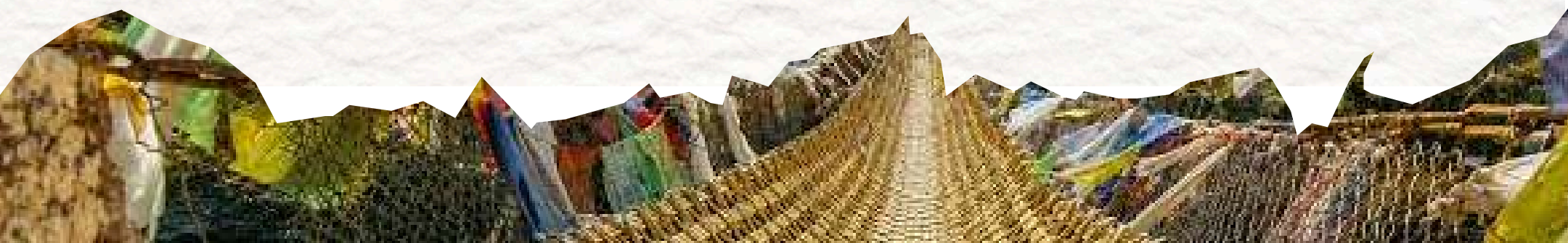
- Ride from Shergaon to Dirang, enjoying the scenic beauty of western Arunachal Pradesh.

- Check in to your hotel, enjoy dinner, and prepare for the next day's ride to Se La Pass & Tawang.

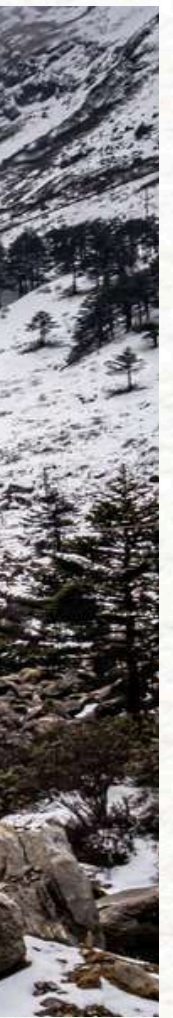




Day 4: Dirang to Tawang | Conquer the Legendary Se La Pass

- Stop at the beautiful Se La Lake, surrounded by pristine mountain landscapes.
- Visit the majestic Jung Waterfall before continuing your scenic ride to Tawang.
- Arrive in Tawang, check in to your hotel, enjoy dinner, and prepare for the next day's Bumla Pass excursion.





Day 5: Zemithang to Lumla | Ride Through Hidden Valleys & the India–Bhutan Border

- Ride from Zemithang to Lumla, passing through remote Himalayan valleys and picturesque villages.

- Arrive in Lumla, surrounded by meadows, traditional villages, and towering Himalayan peaks.

Day 8: Lumla to Dirang | Ride Through the Heart of the Eastern

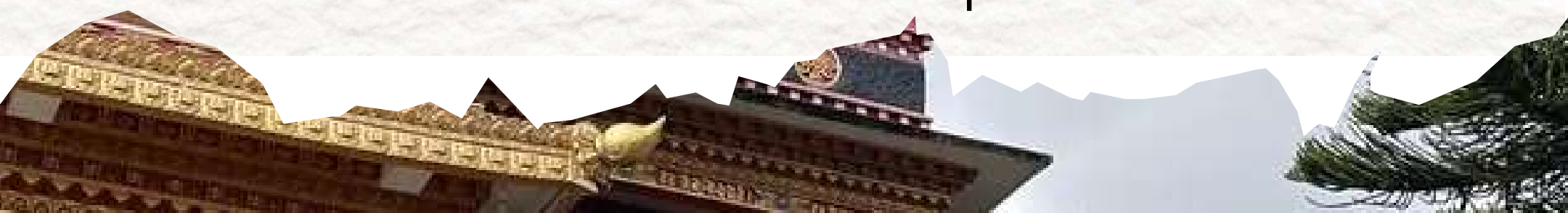
- Ride from Lumla to Dirang, enjoying one final journey through the Eastern Himalayas.

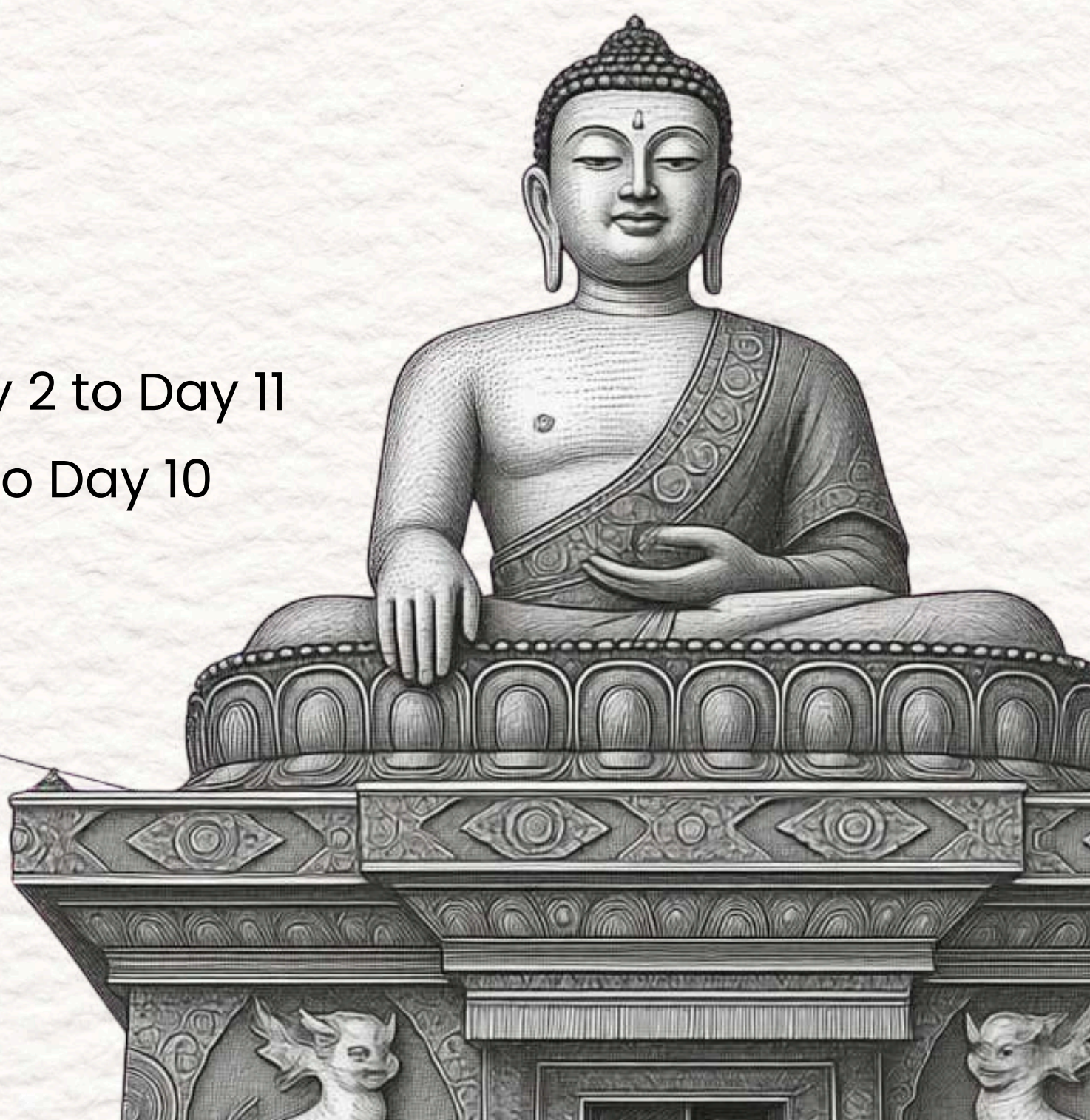

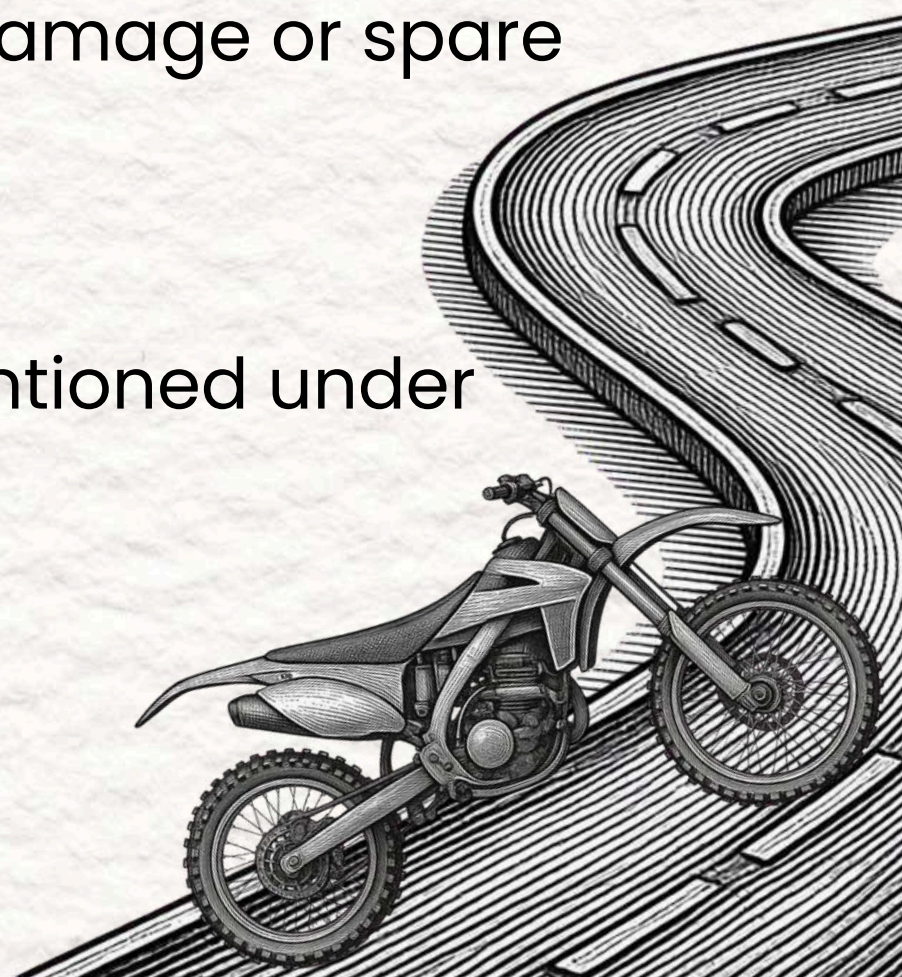

- Airfare, rail fare, or any transportation not mentioned in the inclusions
- Motorcycles are not provided for the Guwahati to Dirang and Dirang to Guwahati transfers
- Lunch and any meals not mentioned in the inclusions
- Entry tickets for sightseeing attractions and optional activities
- Personal expenses such as shopping, laundry, phone calls, tips, etc.
- Early check-in or late check-out at hotels/homestays (subject to availability)
- Extra accommodation or meals due to weather, landslides, roadblocks, or other unforeseen circumstances
- Cost of spare parts or repairs due to damage while the motorcycle is in the rider's possession
- Charges for towing or transporting the motorcycle in case of breakdown or if the rider chooses not to ride
- Refundable security deposit of ₹5,000 per motorcycle (refunded if no damage or spare parts are used)

Notes

- Hotel check-in time is 12:00 PM. Early check-in is subject to room availability.
- International Youth Club reserves the right to cancel a departure if the minimum group size is not met.
- Any additional expenses due to weather, landslides, roadblocks, or other unforeseen circumstances (hotel stay, transportation, meals, etc.) shall be borne by the participant.
- The itinerary may change due to factors beyond our control, such as flight/train delays or cancellations, political disturbances, weather conditions, or natural calamities.
- No refund will be provided if a participant leaves the trip midway. Any cost for transporting the motorcycle to the tour endpoint must be borne by the participant.
- Wearing a helmet, carrying a valid Driving Licence, Government-issued Photo ID, and required permits is mandatory.
- Participants are responsible for the safety of their own luggage. Carry a small daypack for valuables.





Notes

- Any damage caused to the motorcycle, third-party property, or any person during the trip will be the participant's responsibility.
- In case of adverse weather or road conditions, the tour may continue in a Tempo Traveller instead of motorcycles.
- A backup vehicle (Bolero/Camper/Xylo/Innova/Tempo Traveller) will be available throughout the expedition for luggage, mechanical assistance, medical support, and riders facing exhaustion or altitude-related issues.
- A dedicated Royal Enfield mechanic with tools and essential spare parts will accompany the group. Spare parts used during the trip will be chargeable.
- A Basic First Aid Kit and Oxygen Support will be available. Participants are advised to carry their personal medications.
- The Road Captain's instructions must be followed at all times to ensure a safe and successful expedition.
- Foreign Nationals must arrange and pay for any additional permits required.
- Only one backpack/rucksack (up to 60 litres) per rider is allowed in the backup vehicle due to limited luggage space.

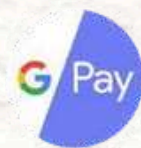
