


EXPLORE SPITI VALLEY

A mountainous cold desert freckled with green patches over a dry weather-beaten face, fascinating valleys, windswept, landscapes and quiet villages, Spiti, which loosely translates as 'the middle land'. The geographic placement passes a heavy influence of Buddhism and stark cultural similarities of the region into the valley.

several Buddhist monasteries and stunning natural sites. most of which are unexplored and hence, unspoilt. Snuggled in Himachal Pradesh, the valley boasts a jagged landscape that is cut by the pristine and fastflowing Spiti river, gushing through deep gorges and valleys. The river is very popular enthusiasts, especially surrounded by snowcapped mountains, is

ideal for lovers of adventure-sports like trekking, paragliding and camping. Spiti is often referred to as Little Tibet because its terrain, vegetation and climate are very similar to that of Tibet. It is perched at a height of 2,745 m above sea level and is surrounded by Lahaul, Ladakh, Kinnaur and Kullu. From Lahaul, one can enter Kumzum La or Kumzum a height of 14,931 ft.

- Key Monastery is the largest and oldest monastery of the Spiti Valley and a religious training center for lamas. It reportedly had 100 monks in 1855. It is about 12 km north of Kaza and 210 km from Manali by road.

Day 04: Kaza to Pin Valley and Tabo to Kaza:

- After breakfast, explore Pin Valley and Tabo
- Pin Valley Pin is a beautiful valley in Lahaul & Spiti district of Himachal Pradesh; formed by Pin River that runs throughout its length, before merging with Spiti River. This valley is also the location of a wildlife reserve called "Pin Valley National Park". Though within Spiti, the ecosystem of Pin Valley is completely different than that of Spiti and its pristine beauty is quite fascinating.
- Tabo Often referred to as the 'Ajanta of the Himalayas', the Tabo Chos-Khor Monastery was founded more than a thousand years ago in 996 A.D. Untouched by the trials and tribulations of humanity, it has preserved its glorious heritage, traditions and culture of Buddhism through the centuries. Standing serenely in the cold and rocky Tabo Valley, this ancient monastery shows amazing architectural integrity and spiritual richness.
- After enjoying and exploring the beautiful Pin Valley and Tabo, return to Kaza for the night.

Day 05: Kaza to Chandratal:

- After breakfast travel to Chandratal
- Trek to Chandratal Lake
- Chandratal Lake Beautifully nestled between the mountains of Spiti Valley on Samudra Tal plateau, Chandratal is a 2.5 km wide freshwater lake that beckons tourists from all across the world.
- Later enjoy the camping near the Chandratal Lake
