

SPITI VALLEY

Brief Information

Long winding roads and valleys that present unforgettable glimpses of cold desert and snow-crowned mountains welcome you when you set foot into Spiti Valley. Bordered on all sides by the Himalayas, Spiti Valley, located in Himachal Pradesh, has an altitude of 12,500 feet

above sea level, and gets just around 250 days of sunshine in the year, making it one of the coldest places in the country. With the thick Himalayan snow cutting Spiti off from the rest of the country for around 6 months a year, the summer months are the only time Spiti is directly accessible via motorway.

The term Spiti means 'The Middle Land', as Spiti Valley separates India from Tibet. Scantily populated, Spiti is an adventure lover's paradise, with a number of trekking trails that tourists can choose from. All of these treks start from Kaza (Spiti's capital from where you make your base camp) to various peaks from where you can get panoramic views of the Himalayan mountains. An easy 1.5-kilometre trek along the Spiti River from Dhankar Monastery to Dhankar Lake promises gorgeous views of the villages below. The Dhankar Lake itself is a place where you can sit back and relax amidst the cool mountain air.

Detailed Itinerary for 3 Nights and 4 Days:

Route Description: Kaza (2N) - Chander Tal (1N)

Day 01: (Kaza) Manali to Kaza via Kunzum Pass (185 km)

- On reaching Manali, enjoy your journey to Kaza.
- You will be passing through the magnificent Atal Tunnel.
- Enjoy the stunning view as you drive to Chatru and Batal.
- At 14,931 feet, feel the chills at the Kunzum Pass and then descend into Losar Village, the first village in Spiti Valley.
- Take a short stopover at Losar and enjoy a hot cup of tea and some snacks (on your own), you will continue driving through the stunning landscapes and reach Kaza.
- You will be spending the night at a comfortable hotel in Kaza.

Day 02: (Kaza) Langza, Komik and Hikkim (45 km)

- Enjoy a hearty breakfast before you drive to some of the highest inhabited regions of the world.
- Start your today's journey by visiting the highest village in Asia, Komik, which literally translates to 'eye of a snow cock'.
- You will then proceed to Hikkim for a visit to the world's highest post office in the world and if possible, you may even meet the postmaster and hear his stories.
- After chatting with the postmaster, you will be driving to Langza, a village that is home to the ancient Lang Temple which is estimated to be around 1000 years old.
- You will then drive back down to Kaza.

Day 03: (Chander Tal) Ki, Kibber, Chichim Bridges, Loser to Chander Tal (110 km)

- After having a delicious breakfast, proceed towards the world-famous Ki Monastery nestled between the mountains in a bowl-shaped valley of the small village Langza in Spiti valley.
- You will then go farther up the valley to the picturesque village of Kibber to treasure the expanses of beautiful landscapes and the immeasurable beauty of the snow-tipped mountains.
- Later, pass through the land of snow leopards as you try your luck for spotting the ever-elusive snow leopard while reaching Chicham.
- Visit the Chicham Bridge which is the highest bridge in Asia. Look down the bridge and you will find yourself gaping below, at a 1000 ft. deep gorge.
- Later travel to another spitian wonder, Chander Tal Lake.
- The mystical and beautiful Chandratal Lake, with a striking backdrop of the Chandra Bhaga mountain range, keeps changing its appearance throughout the day.

 After capturing the colors of the beautiful Chandratal Lake, you will drive down to your campsite where you can enjoy a hot supper under the gaze of a million stars.

Day 04: Batal, Chatru, Atal Tunnel to Manali (100 km)

- After waking up to a magical morning, pack your bags and start your journey towards Manali.
- Enjoy the stunning views of Batal and Chatru on your route.
- On reaching Manali, catch your Volvo for the journey onwards.
- Trip Ends.


