DETAILED ITINERARY

Day 1: Delhi to Shimla (Overnight Journey)

- Begin your adventurous journey from Delhi with an overnight transfer to Shimla.
- Meet your fellow adventurers and bond over the excitement of the trip ahead.
- Enjoy a dinner stop en route (at your own cost).
- Sit back and relax as you drive through the scenic highways surrounded by hills.





Day 2: Shimla Arrival – Transfer to Narkanda

- Reach Shimla in the morning and stop for breakfast (at your own cost).
- Freshen up and begin your scenic drive towards Narkanda.
- En route, soak in the dramatic landscapes of Kinnaur and stop at iconic viewpoints:
- Kinnaur Gate the symbolic entrance to the valley.
- Suicide Point a thrilling cliff offering panoramic valley views.
- Rock-Cut Tunnel (Gateway to Kinnaur) a world-famous stretch where the road passes right through massive mountain rock formations, a true highlight for every Spiti traveler.
- Arrive in Narkanda by evening and check into your hotel.
- Spend leisure time amidst apple orchards and the serene mountain atmosphere.
- Dinner and overnight stay at Narkanda.



Day 3: Narkanda – Sangla – Chitkul Village

- After breakfast, start your drive towards the enchanting Sangla Valley, known for its lush greenery and Himalayan charm.
- En route, pass through: **Karcham Dam**, where the road splits towards Sangla and **Reckong Peo** and **Rakcham Village**.
- Arrive at Chitkul, the last inhabited village near the Indo-Tibetan border, fondly called the "Last Village of India."
- Visit **Hindustan ka Akhri Dhaba** the famous eatery at the edge of the road to the border.
- Walk by the **Baspa River** and soak in the raw beauty of the valley.
- Explore traditional wooden houses, local temples, and the warm culture of the Kinnauri people.
- Return to Sangla by evening for dinner and an overnight stay.



Day 4: Sangla – Kaza via Nako, Tabo & Dhankar

- Enjoy breakfast and get ready for a long but incredibly scenic drive towards Kaza, the capital of Spiti Valley.
- En route, witness some of the most iconic spots of Kinnaur and Spiti:
- Khab Sangam the spectacular confluence of the Satluj and Spiti Rivers.
- Nako Village & Nako Lake a serene high-altitude lake surrounded by willow and poplar trees, with a chance to visit Nako Monastery overlooking the valley.
- **Gue Village** home to the naturally preserved 500-year-old mummy of a Buddhist monk.
- **Tabo Monastery** one of the oldest monasteries in the Himalayas (dating back to 996 AD), often called the "Ajanta of the Himalayas" for its ancient murals.
- Dhankar Monastery & Dhankar Village dramatically perched on a cliff with panoramic views of the confluence of Pin and Spiti Rivers.
- Lingti Waterfall a scenic stop where cascading waters enhance the raw beauty of the valley.
- By evening, arrive in Kaza and check into your hotel/guesthouse. Dinner and overnight stay at Kaza.



Day 5: Kaza Local Sightseeing – Spiti Highlights

- After breakfast, set out to explore the hidden gems of Spiti Valley.
- Visit some of the most iconic and high-altitude villages in the world:
- **Key Monastery (Ki Gompa)** the largest and most famous monastery in Spiti, with stunning views of the valley.
- **Kibber Village** known for its stone houses and chances of spotting Himalayan wildlife.
- Chicham Bridge one of Asia's highest suspension bridges, offering jaw-dropping views.
- **Hikkim Village** home to the world's highest post office, where you can mail a postcard from the top of the world.
- **Komic Village** regarded as the highest motorable village in the world.
- Langza Village famous for its giant Buddha statue and the discovery of marine fossils.
- Return to Kaza by evening.
- Dinner and overnight stay at Kaza.




Day 6: Kaza to Sarahan via Kalpa

- On arrival in Kalpa, soak in the mesmerizing views of the sacred Kinnaur Kailash range, a majestic backdrop dotted with apple orchards and traditional wooden houses.
- Move towards Sarahan, visit the famous Bhimakali Temple, a stunning blend of Indo- Tibetan architecture and one of the most revered shrines in Himachal Pradesh.
- Dinner and overnight stay in Sarahan.



Day 7: Sarahan – Shimla – Departure for Delhi

- After breakfast, begin your drive back towards Shimla, retracing the scenic mountain roads.
- En route, admire the ever-changing landscapes of Kinnaur and Himachal, from rugged valleys to lush green forests.
- Reach Shimla by evening and board your overnight vehicle for Delhi.
- Carry back unforgettable memories of the breathtaking Spiti Valley and the serene Kinnaur region.




