### Day 1: Arrive in Guwahati – Discover & Unwind

- Cross the Bhutan border and witness a dramatic change in landscapes – from dense forests to endless mountain curves.
- Be mesmerized by panoramic views of towering, grassclad mountains and untouched natural beauty at every turn.
- Reach Bomdila and check-in to your cozy hilltop accommodation.
- Unwind and enjoy a delicious hot dinner.
- Overnight stay in the serene and scenic town of Bomdila.







### Day 3: Bomdila to Tawang (176 km | 5.5 hours)

- Begin your scenic drive to the enchanting town of Tawang.

- Nyukmadung War Memorial A moving tribute to the brave hearts of the 1962 Indo-China War.
- Sela Pass / Tunnels (13,700 ft) Drive through snowcovered peaks and one of the highest motorable mountain passes in India.
- Jaswant Garh War Memorial Honouring the legendary bravery of Rifleman Jaswant Singh Rawat.
- Jung Waterfalls Soak in the beauty of this breathtaking waterfall nestled in the mountains.
- Arrive in Tawang and check-in to your accommodation.
- Enjoy a delicious dinner & overnight stay in Tawang amidst the peaceful Himalayan vibes.





# Day 4: Tawang to Bum La Pass & Back (100 km | 4–5 hours)

- Rise early as we need to leave by 8 AM after a hearty breakfast.
- Embark on an adventurous drive to Bum La Pass (15,200 ft) – the Indo-China border.
- Feel a wave of patriotism as you interact with Indian soldiers and get a rare glimpse of Chinese military posts.
- En route, explore:
- **Y-Junction** A strategic point where roads diverge to Bum La and other army posts.
- P.T. Tso Lake A crystal-clear high-altitude lake surrounded by majestic snow-capped peaks.
- Madhuri Lake / Sungester Lake Known for its cinematic beauty and serene vibes.
- Taktsang Monastery A peaceful monastery nestled in the Himalayas.
- Return to Tawang by evening.
- Enjoy a warm, comforting dinner and Overnight stay in Tawang.





### Day 5: Exploring Tawang (60–70 km | Relaxed Day)

Mechanic with spare parts and tools. They are well trained to handle large groups. The spares used on the way will be chargeable.

- Backing vehicle Bolero/Camper/Xylo/Innova/tempo for mechanical and medical support.
- In case of an emergency, if any rider is feeling uneasy then he can sit in the backup.
- Only one rucksack/backpack of 60 liters will be adjusted as it will be having tools and spares too.
